ENTRY FEES: Amateur + all Cruisers \$45.00 per Rider per Class
NZ Junior & Elite Domestic UCI Round \$50.00
Pro Super Class 20" (Sunday) \$45.00
(17yr+ Male and Female classes, Riders must also ride Elite or Age class.)

SCRUTINEERING: Officials will randomly check bikes before and during the event, including all official practice and warm up sessions when safety gear and number plates must be worn. It is recommended that CLUBS scrutineer all bikes prior to the event.

NUMBER PLATES: Number Plates will be checked for correct numbers at Registration.
NZ or World numbers may be used. Numbers & prefixes must be easily readable.

PLATE COLOURS: Refer BMX NZ handbook. (2008 colours.)

REGISTRATION: All Registrations are to be completed on Friday 21 March;
M11 Test Teams; 8.30am - 9.00am.
All other Classes (including Junior, Elite) 10.00am - 5.00pm.

Number plates & Licences must be presented (NO EXCEPTIONS).

OFFICIALS MEETING: - Officials 8.30am FRI, SAT & SUN.

CLUB TEAM MANAGERS MEETING: 9-00am SATURDAY & SUNDAY.

OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY & MARCH PAST – FRIDAY:
12.30pm - Riders assemble behind start hill, alphabetically by CLUB.
12.45pm - March Past.
1.05pm - Opening Ceremony and speeches.

SATURDAY: Practice Times (with gates):
8.00am - 8.45am - AM session Amateur riders only.
8.50am - 9.10am - Elite Classes Only.

AM SESSION: Racing Starts 9.30am.

PM SESSION Practice at the completion of AM session.
Racing starts after completion of Practice.

SUNDAY: Practice Times (with gates):
7.30am - 8.30am - All classes.
8.30am - 8.45am - Elite Classes Only.
Racing Starts 9.00am - all classes.
(No separate AM & PM session).

MOTO DRAW: BMX NZ Computer moto mixing and lane draws will be used.

POINTS: 1 – 2 – 3 – 4 – 5 – 6 – 7 – 8 (8 Lane Gate).

4 riders constitute a class (amalgamations as required).

Racing Format: **SATURDAY**
AM & PM Session: 4 motos all classes.

SUNDAY
8 or less riders: 3 motos, last one with the Finals.
9-24 riders: 2 motos, top 8 to Final
25-40 riders: 2 motos, ½ Finals, Final.
41 + riders: 2 motos, ¼ Finals, ½ Finals, Final.

NOTES:

1. ¼ and ½ finals, computer 'snake' seeding, equal placings and runoffs per BMX NZ Handbook.
2. All finals are Deadman, with Olympic lane draws.
3. In case of disruption or adverse weather, moto format may be changed, at the discretion of Race Director, Chief Commissaire and BMX NZ.

JUNIOR & ELITE 20" FORMAT: (NZ UCI riders only)
Saturday - UCI format utilised, 3 qualifying Motos, with finals as required.
This NZ UCI event will be used to determine NZ Junior and Elite 20" placings.

SUPERCLASS FORMAT, '17+, Male and Female classes: (Sunday Only)
3 qualifying motos, points over a set of 3 finals for the top 8 riders after the motos.
The Lone Star BMX NZ Superclass Series rules apply including no runoffs, and semi's as required.

UCI & SUPERCLASS PURSE: MINIMUM \$4,000.00 for the Weekend
To be split proportionally between Male and Female for each class according to numbers entered.
Payout to 8th place. Sat UCI purse \$2000. Super Class purse \$2000. Applicable payout percentages will apply. Riders must enter another Junior, Elite or Amateur class to be eligible to enter the Superclass event on Sunday.

AWARDS & TROPHY ALLOCATION:
Perpetual Cups to all 1st Place Winners
Classes including UCI 13 and younger:
Proportional Trophies per the BMX NZ Handbook.
Classes UCI 14 +, including Junior and Elite 20" & Cruiser, but excluding Superclass:
Trophies 1-3 only.

Medallions for all participants.
Numbered Plates to Junior and Elite 20" Finalists.
Certificates will be sent to clubs as soon as available.

2008 Nationals Mighty 11's Teams Selection

Friday 21 March 2008 North Avon Christchurch BMX Club, Bexley Reserve Christchurch

Mighty 11 Test Team Criteria:

A team of five riders will be selected to travel to Australia to represent NZ in the
Mighty 11's Cultural Exchange and Australia vs. New Zealand Mighty 11's Test

The selection is open to **all riders** who will be 11 years old (actual age) on **1 June 2008**.

(Riders, who were selected the year prior, due to qualification date changes, are not eligible for repeat selection. All riders are to have one opportunity for selection.)

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. ALL riders **MUST** compete in the 2008 BMX NZ National Championships
2. Selected Riders and Guardians will be required to sign and comply with the BMX NZ Test Teams Contract. (Copies available upon request from the Administrator). Contracts to be signed and returned by 30 April 2008.
3. Riders must attend arranged team training sessions as arranged by BMX NZ Team Management.
4. Riders **MUST** be available to travel to Australia – departing 29 May 2008 and returning 9 June 2008. During this period riders will be billeted or accommodated only as arranged by BMX NZ team management. (Late returns with family are possible by arrangement.)
5. All riders must have current passports.
6. ALL riders must abide by the rules and regulations as set by BMX NZ.

POINTS:

1 – 2 – 3 – 4 – 5 – 6 – 7 – 8 BMX NZ Moto Mixing.

FORMAT:

All Riders - 4 qualifying motos. Each rider's 3 lowest moto points will be added, then;

8 or less riders:

Points added to 5th (final) moto to determine top 5 placings.

9 - 24 riders:

Top 8 riders to 1 final, points added to '3 best moto' points.

25 + riders:

Top 16 riders race ½ Finals, points added to '3 best moto' points,

Top 8 riders to final, points added to previous points.

FURTHER NOTES:

- *Run offs to determine ½ Finals position.*
- *Count back to determine Finals position, ½ finals placing, last 'counted' moto placing and so on.*
- *Finish position in Final will determine team selection if points tied at the end of racing.*
- *Olympic lane draw for ½ Finals and Finals.*
- *Information contained within this flyer supersedes, where necessary the current BMX NZ Handbook.*
- *Final selections at the discretion of BMX NZ and Team Selectors.*
